The Ballet Conservatoire Syllabus is more demanding than the more common Royal Academy of Dance (RAD) Syllabus.

Students should not be discouraged; this is a wonderful opportunity to learn at a world-class standard.

The Ballet Conservatoire Syllabus follows the Vaganova school of teaching, and presents a standard of classical education that aligns with leading academies worldwide. The BC Syllabus has been the syllabus of choice for countless leading schools, including: the Australian Conservatoire of Ballet, Queensland National Ballet School, En Pointe Studios, & many more in over 40 countries internationally. This gives students the successful preparation and knowledge to pursue any future dance dream they might have.

Ballet Conservatoire is not a yearly syllabus. It is normal for students to only attend an exam every one-two years, depending on their age and development. The higher grades have significant increases in work load, and require additional development time, ie. two years per grade.

Ballet Conservatoire is a training syllabus. Unlike the more common RAD Syllabus (which itself is only an exam syllabus, ie. steps are learnt for exam purposes only and not meant for solely training technique), the BC Syllabus is directly designed to train students correct and safe technique, at a professional level, from a young age.
